Respect: Our organization is strengthened by our shared commitment to each other, the communities we serve, and our thoughtful consideration of differing experiences and perspectives.

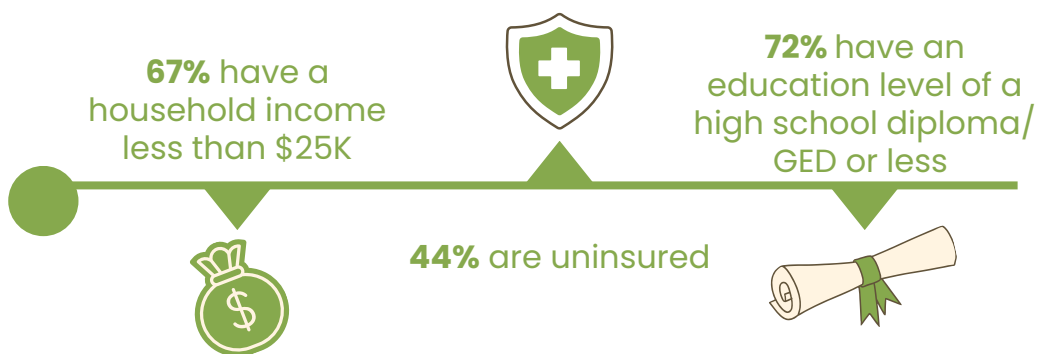
