Half of nonprofits surveyed reported workforce shortages due to stress and burnout²




Solution:

CHWs contribute to increased workforce capacity, reduced burnout and lower turnover.


RISING OPERATING COSTS

Things like medical supplies, prescriptions, and outside services make up about 30–40% of a typical health system's costs⁴

CHWs help people manage their healthcare needs in smarter, more affordable ways – lowering overall costs.

In a clinical trial, patients were significantly less likely to experience 30-day hospital readmissions if paired with a CHW.⁷

Solution:

CHW improve health outcomes: fewer hospital readmissions, better chronic disease management, improved preventive care and more.
